New Charge Policy:

- Students with Free Status will not be allowed to have a negative balance
- Students with Reduced Status will be allowed to charge up to 6 meals or the equivalent of \$2.40

Students with Paid Status:

- Goodyear, Memorial, and Central School Students will be allowed to carry a negative balance of 3 meals or the equivalent of \$7.50
- Intermediate Students will be allowed to carry negative balance of 2 meals or the equivalent of \$6.00
- High School Students will be allowed to carry negative balance of 1 meals or the equivalent of \$3.00

If a student reaches his or her balance limit, the student will be offered an alternative meal which will consist of a Cheese Sandwich, fruit, vegetable, & milk.

These alternative meals will be charged to the student's lunch account at the standard rate. Parents/Guardians are responsible for payment of these meals to the School Nutrition Program.

Additionally, once a student reaches the maximum negative balance, no ala carte items will be sold to the student and all transactions may become a cash basis transaction.

All student accounts that hold a negative balance currently from the 2014-2015 school year will begin the 2015-2016 with this policy in effect.

Enclosed in this packet you will find your student's account balance letter and instructions on how you can set up an account to track and add money to your student's account.
