Accomplishments

Killingly robotics teams competed this past weekend in the Tipping Point Robotics qualifier at Middletown High School. Builders Alex Potapskiy, Ryan Rattray, Matthew Sprouse, and Aila Gutierrez completely redesigned the robot from their previous competition. Joshua Torre autonomously programmed the game to ensure maximum win points while sophomores Abigail Berube and Emma Miller recorded all the work in the engineering design notebook, resulting in Team M earning the Connecticut Engineering Design Award! Having already been qualified for the US National Robotics Championship, as well as the Southern New England Regional Championship which will take place later this year. None of this would have been possible without the incredible effort by the entire team, an excellent example of how hard work pays off.

The Killingly Robotics team competes next in the Southern New England Regional Championship on March 5th and 6th in Framingham, Massachusetts.
