Activity: Laundry Counter



Materials: Clean laundry

Directions:

Have your child be your laundry counter. When folding laundry, ask your child, "How many socks did we wash?" Invite them to count out loud. Pair the socks up and ask them "How many pairs of socks did we wash?" Do they want to keep counting? How about shirts? Or towels? Or pants?

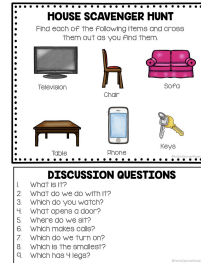
Speech/Language Supports:

This activity supports your child's IEP speech/language goals and objectives by encouraging joint attention, matching, categorization, and labeling of clothing items.

Speech/Language Extensions:

Model and encourage your child to use their mode of communication (gestures, pictures, signs, talker, vocalizations, and/or verbalization) to label items you use doing laundry. For example, label shirts, pants, socks, towels, wash cloths, soap, laundry basket, washer, and dryer.
