I am again writing to request that the Board of Ed stream their meetings via the Town of Killingly or Killingly Public Schools Facebook Live page. The benefits of this are improved accessibility to parents and an archive that parents/community members can access outside of the actual meeting times. As previously stated in the email below and other emails to Board members, the audio/visual quality of the Ch 22 livestream is very poor, inaccessible, and there is no archive—if you cannot make the meeting you are out of luck. Parent and community member engagement should be of the highest priority—currently there is no central or up to date location to find information on the most recent meetings. The last posted minutes are from June 11, 2020, that is totally unacceptable.

All other Town of Killingly Boards/Commissions are actively using the FB platform. As a parent and staff member who would like to be more actively involved, I'm starting to get the distinct feeling that the Board would rather leave us in the dark—there is a “better way” and it seems you are choosing not to use it.
