

Student-Led Conferences at Killingly Intermediate School

Student-Led Conferences are a way to empower students as experts in their own learning, and highlights their voices and insights to drive a rich discussion.

Objectives of Student-Led Conferences:

- Promote the mission of KIS by providing the opportunity for students to engage in authentic ways of thinking, ways of working, tools for working and skills for living in the world
- Students assume greater responsibility and accountability of academic progress and habits of work
- Parents, teachers, and students engage in open dialogue
- Increased parent attendance at conferences
- Increased opportunity for student self-reflection and self-evaluation
- To emphasize our student-centered philosophy
- To build open relationships with families

Role of Student:

- The student is the center of the Student-Led Conferences. Teachers guide the students through the conference process and help the students prepare, but they are responsible for leading the conversation with parents and teachers during their conference time.
- Each student maintains a portfolio to showcase progress in all content areas throughout the year.
- Students complete the Student Reflection Form for each content area, along with the Student SLC script. The Student SLC script allows students to reflect on their strengths, weaknesses, pieces of work, and future goals.

Role of Teacher:

- The teacher guides the student through the conference and helps the student prepare.
- Each homeroom teacher supports students creating a portfolio of student work. Selected assignments are included in the portfolio.
- Teachers are responsible for helping students select assignments to highlight at the conference and for providing class time for this purpose.

Role of Parent:

- The parent/guardian is the second most essential attendee to the conference.
- Parents/guardians should be briefed about the format and objectives of the SLC so that the conference runs smoothly.


