SCHOOL GOVERNANCE COUNCILS

WHAT IS A SCHOOL GOVERNANCE COUNCIL?

School Governance Councils are an opportunity for Connecticut schools to become centers of excellence that prepare all students for success. They represent the many interests of the families and staff that make up your school's community. This is important because research has shown that:

- Partnerships among families, school and community members can make a powerful contribution to greater student success.
- No matter what their income or background, students with involved families tend to have higher grades and test scores, better attendance, and higher rates of homework completion.

WHAT DOES THE SCHOOL GOVERNANCE COUNCIL DO? The School Governance Council serves as an important role to the school administrator by:

- Bringing together parents, school staff, students and community leaders to work together to improve student achievement and
- 2. Assisting the school administration in decisions impacting students' education in areas such as:
 - Analyze data and school needs;
 - Review the school's resources; and
 - Advise the principal in making programmatic and operational changes.

WHAT DOES IT REQUIRE TO BE ON THE SCHOOL GOVERNANCE COUNCIL?

Serving as a council member will require time, energy and a willingness to listen. Members should:

- Put children first;
- Be a team player; and
- Be willing to learn.

Morning & Afternoon Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures

Please follow the directions of crossing guards and other school personnel. Students must only be dropped off/picked up from the inside lane, closest to the building, or from a designated parking spot.


Am Drop-off 7:00-7:15

- Use only the inside lane closest to the building (inside the cones)
- Pull all the way to the end to allow other cars to pull up
- Students should exit on right side of vehicle
- · Cars may go around cars taking longer to unload
- Be mindful of crosswalks

PM Pick-up 2:15-2:30

- Use the inside lane closest to the building (inside the cones)
- Pull all the way to the end to allow other cars to pull up
- If the pick-up entry lane is full, proceed to the overflow baseball lot or overflow football lot (see diagram)
- Students are not allowed to cross in the front two crosswalks without an adult
- After 2:20, traffic is much lighter

Please follow the same procedures for drop-off and pick-up from after school events (dances, concerts, etc.)

VISITOR MANAGEMENT~ PROCEDURES

VISITOR MANAGEMENT ~ BUILDING ACCESS AUTHORIZATION

Upon arrival at the school's main office all visitors shall present to office personnel and request access by stating their name, company affiliation and intended business. All visitors must register by providing a valid photo driver's license. The office secretary will process the request for access in compliance with approved visitor management procedures and protocols. Appropriate identification will be issued based on the following protocol...

- Visitors not requesting access to locations within the building (inside the building) or the premises (outside the building) shall not require a formal printed identification. However, the details of the visit shall be entered in the visitor management system (ie: parent pickup, etc.) All necessary business shall take place in the confines of the main office. Visitor shall exit the building directly through the predetermined designated main entrance area.
- Visitors requesting access to locations within the building (inside the building) or the premises (outside the building) shall require a formal printed identification. The visitor shall present a valid photo driver's license. The driver's license will be retained by office personnel and shall be securely maintained in the main office throughout the visit. The provided ID shall be worn in plain view throughout the visit. At the end of the visit the visitor must return to the man office for checkout. The visitor's identification badge (badge, clip or breakaway lanyard) must be relinquished at which time the visitor's driver's license will be returned. Visitors shall exit the building directly through the predetermined designated main entrance area.
- Employees (except for operations and maintenance and food service personnel) requesting access to the building where they are <u>assigned</u> shall enter or exit through the designated main entrance or other authorized entrance. Employees authorized to leave the building shall sign out in the main office by utilizing the visitor management system. Employees returning to the building shall sign in at the main office by utilizing the visitor management system.
- Employees (except for operations and maintenance and food service personnel) requesting access to buildings that they are <u>not assigned</u> shall enter or exit through the predetermined designated main entrance. Employees shall immediately report to the main office and shall sign in by utilizing the visitor management system. Employees exiting the building shall sign out in the main office by utilizing the visitor management system.

KILLINGLY PUBLIC SCHOOLS CANCELLATIONS, DELAYED OPENINGS, & EARLY DISMISSALS

To: Parents, Guardians, and KPS Staff.

In the event of stormy weather, cancellations, delayed openings, and early dismissals will be announced on the radio and TV as early as possible. In order to help you prepare for morning childcare and/or supervision, ALL DELAYED OPENINGS WILL BE TWO (2) HOURS. When there is a 2-hour delay, there is no breakfast program and no morning preschool.

Our automated telephone calling system will contact you if there is a delay, cancellation or early dismissal. Please be sure that schools have your correct telephone number on file.

In the event of a 2-hour delay, a child's bus will be delayed by the same amount of time. For example, when school is delayed a student who is usually picked up at 7:00 a.m. will be picked up at 9:00 a.m.

EARLY DISMISSAL HOURS

When there is an early dismissal, there is no afternoon preschool. Goodyear childcare is open until 5:00 p.m. Killingly Childcare Program sites are open until 6:00 p.m., unless otherwise directed by the Superintendent.

Early dismissal hours are: KHS-12:05 p.m. KIS-12:10 p.m. KCS-1:20 p.m. KMS-1:20 p.m.

Goodyear: Pre-K morning students will be dismissed at 10:45 a.m. Dismissal for full-day Pre-k students will be at 12:45 p.m. There will be no afternoon preschool session.

HOURS FOR KILLINGLY CHILDCARE PROGRAMS WHEN SCHOOLS ARE CLOSED

Goodyear Childcare will open at 9:00 a.m. when schools are closed.

Killingly Childcare Programs for students in grades k-8 will be combined and held only at the KMS location from 8:00 a.m.- 6:00 p.m.

SPECIAL EARLY DISMISSAL

In an effort to reduce the number of school cancelations, **in rare circumstances** the superintendent may elect to have a **SPECIAL EARLY DISMISSAL** and dismiss students about one hour earlier that a typical early dismissal schedule. Many storms in the past have either started or intensified around 2:30 p.m.

When there is a SPECIAL EARLY DISMISSAL there is no afternoon preschool. Goodyear childcare is open until 5:00 p.m.

The Killingly Childcare Program sites are open until 6:00 p.m., unless otherwise directed by the Superintendent.

SPECIAL EARLY DISMISSAL HOURS are: KHS-10:55 a.m. KIS-10:55 a.m. KCS-12:05 p.m. KMS-12:05 p.m.

Goodyear: Pre-K morning students will be dismissed at 10:45 a.m. Dismissal for full-day Pre-k students will be at 11:30 a.m. There will be no afternoon preschool session.

The SPECIAL EARLY DISMISSAL schedule will have an impact on lunch for students, create a condensed schedule, and may require staffs' lunch/prep times to be moved to the end of the day. School principals will set forth a schedule that is appropriate for each building.

If the DISTRICT is closed (no offices opened) ALL Killingly Childcare Program sites are CLOSED.

Parents of elementary and intermediate students should make arrangements to receive students at home if there is an early dismissal. Either arrange to be home early, or arrange for a relative or neighbor to provide supervision. Parents need to let schools know of any changes for early dismissal. Please inform your child of your plans in the case of an early dismissal.
